# FROM BOARD OF TRUSTEES CORONOVIRUS UPDATE

The Board of Trustees have been following the local website <a href="https://gov.gg/coronavirus">https://gov.gg/coronavirus</a> closely and have come to the decision that this the time to advise all WI groups to cancel their meetings, social occasions and fundraising events immediately until the end of April. The Sports and Leisure committee have already cancelled the darts league and will monitor the situation for the individual and team knockout competitions.

This of course means that the Annual Council Meeting on 22 April has been postponed, probably until the autumn. The Fun Quiz on 21 May (see below) is now cancelled.

NFWI has been updating its information regularly and most WIs in the UK seem to be cancelling their meetings. NFWI have announced they have taken the difficult decision that the Annual Meeting at the Royal Albert Hall on 4 June should be cancelled.
